



OFGS Academic Scholarships: overview of Terms

Oxford Falls Grammar School offers a robust, diverse and high-quality academic program. As part of this it is pleased to offer academic scholarships to high calibre students performing at exemplary levels.

The OFGS Academic Scholarship examination is managed by Academic Assessment Services. Students may qualify for consideration for an Academic Scholarship if their examination results fall within the top 10% of the cohort.

A scholarship may be awarded to the student/s with the highest overall score or to one with the highest score in a particular domain. This enables the School to recognise outstanding all-round or specialised abilities and performances. Only in exceptional circumstances will applicants with results below the top 10% be considered for a scholarship.

All scholarships are tenable to Year 12, provided that recipients continue to meet the scholarship criteria. Scholarship students are expected to demonstrate exemplary academic performance and approach to learning. They are committed to high levels of participation in the school co-curricular program, particularly enrichment opportunities and they demonstrate consistently high standards of citizenship.

In the area of personal conduct, any scholarship recipient is to set an example to the School community through their conduct. It is important that attitude, diligence, attendance, participation, deportment, positive relationships and support for the School's Christian ethos are maintained at an exemplary level.

Should any one or more of these areas come under question the scholarship may be placed under consideration for review. If issues arise in either the academic or conduct areas our first objective would be to work together with the student and parents to provide wellbeing support and academic guidance, and address and rectify any concerns; however, the School maintains the right to terminate a scholarship should the conditions ultimately not be adequately fulfilled. Please note that this document is summative only; further and full details of the contractual obligations of our Scholarship Terms and Conditions will be provided upon offer of a scholarship.

Please note that if a student is awarded an academic scholarship, a bond of \$3,600 is payable prior to their enrolment at Oxford Falls Grammar School. This bond is subject to the same conditions as all enrolments in the School.
